As you make determinations for FY23 Community Project Funding, I urge you to consider my request for the Danville Police Vehicle Upgrade.

This project requests \$65,000 from the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Technology & Equipment funding to purchase two new police cruisers for the Town of Danville Police Department. The Town of Danville has not been able to purchase a new police cruiser since 1998. The limited budget of Danville has made it difficult for the police department to acquire a dependable new vehicle for their officers to have to ensure the safety of their city. In addition, restrictions as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic led to additional duties on the police force in order to protect their constituents. The increase in homelessness accompanied with mental health and substance abuse issues has increased the need for dependable emergency services for our citizens.
